IF THIS HAPPENS	DO THIS
<b>TANKER/VEHICLE ACCIDENT</b>	Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away. Warn other traffic. Check for spills and leaks. <b>Call the emergency services: Dial 111</b>
<b>SPILL OR LEAK</b>	Wear overalls, chemical resistant boots and gloves and safety goggles. Prevent further spillage or leakage. Absorb spilled product with inert material and place in a sealable container. Wash affected area with water detergent solution. Absorb washings and place in sealed container. Dispose of to a suitable landfill.
<b>FIRE</b>	<b>Call the Fire Service: Dial 111.</b> Wear protective clothing including self-contained breathing apparatus. Toxic fumes may be released. Keep people away. Extinguish fires with foam, dry chemical, carbon dioxide or fine water spray. Cool other containers to prevent rupture. Contain run-off.

**FIRST AID**

<b>IF SWALLOWED</b>	Do NOT induce vomiting to avoid aspiration toxicity. <b>For advice call the National Poisons Centre 0800 764 766 or a Doctor immediately</b>
<b>IF IN EYES</b>	Hold eyes open and rinse with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses if easy to do so. Call a Doctor or National Poisons Centre for advice if irritation persists.
<b>IF ON SKIN / HAIR</b>	Immediately wash affected areas with soap and running water. Wash contaminated clothing before reuse. Call a Doctor or National Poisons Centre for advice if irritation persists or an allergic sensitisation occurs.
<b>IF INHALED</b>	Immediately move to fresh air and rest. Maintain half upright position if breathing is difficult. <b>For advice call the National Poisons Centre 0800 764 766 or a Doctor immediately.</b>
